Important Notes

- To disconnect the batteries for storage or shipping press and hold the power button for 20 s.
- To reconnect the batteries after storage or shipping plug in external power.
- Disabling MS2AppKeypadHelper prevents the proper operation of the keypad and other features. Don't disable the MS2AppKeypadHelper [8291]
- To aid in the removal of SD or SIM cards a small piece of tape can be placed on the top of the card. Use care to not put any tape on the contact pads.
- Only use the specified size of SIM cards. Adapters damage pins.[8197]

Known Issues

- The MS2 should be left on or off when charging. There have been isolated cases of failure to charge when left in connected standby. [8338]
- System time is not consistently accurate. If accurate time is needed it should be acquired from the GPS.[8350]
- Some batteries report low capacity even if the function of the battery is within specifications. [8140]
- If searches are slow after restoring factory settings it may be necessary to re-index. Open Settings, find Indexing Options, click Advanced, click Rebuild, and allow time for it to reindex.[8345,8313]
- The gain on the internal microphones has to be turned up significantly to record. [8316]
- Audio from the on board speaker is the left side only.[8135]
