## OS Build 24198

### For Mesa® 4 Rugged Tablets Running Windows® 11 OS

These notes include important information for our Mesa 4 customers regarding the most recent release of the Mesa 4 Windows 11 OS.

#### OS Updates (New Devices and OS Patch)

- Updated Quectel GNSS driver. This update fixes a GNSS lag with Windows Location Services.
- Updated Silicon Labs CP210x USB to UART driver to version 04/13/2023,11.3.0.176.
- Added automatic APN setup for FloLIVE SIM cards.
- Updated the Juniper Device Settings app:
  - Added a storage feature to the Misc screen for proper long-term battery storage.
  - Added registry value to hide the Update screen:  
`[HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\Juniper Systems]  
"HideUpdatePage"=dword00000001`
- Updated Juniper drivers:
  - Fixed a memory leak in the EC driver and Expansion driver.
  - Added support for a new custom expansion type.
- Modified the Juniper update mechanism:
  - Fixed an issue that allowed an older OS patch to be applied to a newer OS build.
  - Fixed an issue where the update notification could erroneously appear the first time a tablet was powered on.
  - Fixed an update notification that could erroneously appear during updates.
  - Fixed the update mechanism so it does not attempt to update drivers for devices disabled in the BIOS.
