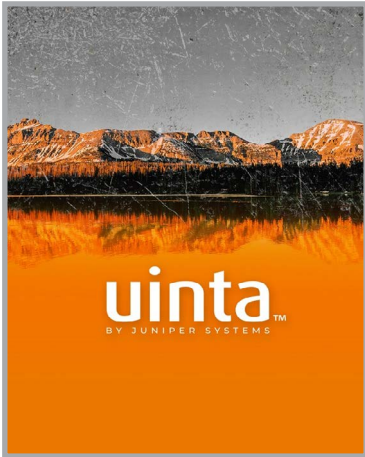

New Features and Enhancements

- Improved Navigation UI
- Compass integration for calibrated devices
- Photo capture improvements
- PDF report layout improvements
- Additional shape icons

Bug Fixes

- Fixed cloud sync authentication errors requiring multiple logins
- Fixed image rotation issues in PDF export
- Fixed errors when deleting attachments/photos from offline database
- Fixed list view to correctly display related table subsections
- Fixed crashes when viewing the calendar
- Fixed errors when searching text with apostrophe or quote characters
- Fixed list fields losing options when being edited from multiple devices

- Fixed attachment/photo syncing to wrong cloud account when switching projects
- Fixed crash in map view when dragging vertices by mouse

Known Issues

- **Backwards compatibility:** Devices sharing data in a cloud project should use the same version of Uinta. New features in Uinta 1.5 and later are not backwards compatible and could cause older versions to crash.
- **Large data sets:** Importing large data sets (10,000+ features/records) into a cloud project is not recommended at this time. Using offline reference layers such as mbtiles is preferred. This issue will be addressed in a future version. Please contact Juniper Systems if you need help supporting large data sets.
