Updates

- GPS is now included in device capability reporting—for application compatibility
- Improvements to touchscreen and touch profiles
- RS-232 configuration screen now displays voltage for handhelds with a 12-volt RS-232 port expansion pod
- Security updates

Resolved Issues

- Disable touchscreen no longer automatically re-enables after resuming handheld from suspend
- Leaving handheld suspended for several days will no longer cause it to crash
- Handheld no longer crashes after resuming device from suspend with certain apps running
- Handheld no longer crashes when the Windows key is pressed on an external keyboard
- Improved stability and performance of the RS-232 port
- Improved accuracy of battery charge level reporting and better detection of older batteries
