- 1. On the Allegro CX click on the Bluetooth Icon in the lower right corner of the task bar.

- c. First turn on the Bluetooth transmitter if it is not already on. (located at the top of the pop up) it should say "Turn Transmitter OFF" when the Bluetooth is turned on.

- 4. Now on the Allegro CX click on the Bluetooth icon select "Bluetooth ActiveSync"
 - a. When the "Bluetooth" devices pop up then select your computer that you have paired with your Allegro CX. Click on the "Select" Button.
 - b. Wait up to One minute, but your Allegro CX should connect and you should be able to browse the contents of the device via Windows Mobile device center.
- 5. When you go to connect your Allegro CX in the future, you should Open Windows Mobile Device Center first. And repeat step 4 and your Allegro should connect to Windows Mobile Device Center.
